## **EDF Energies Nouvelles brings into service 36 MW in wind energy capacity in Greece**

**EDF Energies Nouvelles has announced the entry into service of two new wind farms in Greece.**

The 24 MW Perdikovouni and 12 MW Kalyva facilities, developed by EEN Hellas, a Greek subsidiary of EDF Energies Nouvelles, are now up and running. They are equipped with 12 windmills supplied by Danish group Vestas, each with a unit capacity of 3 MW.

These two new wind farms, which have a total capacity of 36 MW, are wholly-owned by EEN Hellas. The commissioning of these two facilities has increased EEN Hellas' net installed capacity to 110 MW.

The Group also pursues the development and sale of structured assets, which consists primarily in selling renewable energy generating assets to individuals or to energy services companies. EDF Energies Nouvelles is a 50%-owned subsidiary of the EDF group. Since 28 November 2006, EDF Energies Nouvelles has been listed in Compartment A of Eurolist by Euronext Paris (code: EEN, ISIN code: FR0010400143).
