## **EDF Energies Nouvelles has signed a further agreement with MidAmerican Energy Company in the United States concerning a 75 MW extension to the Pomeroy wind farm**

**EDF Energies Nouvelles has announced the signature of an agreement with MidAmerican Energy Company concerning the development and construction of a 75-megawatt wind farm in Iowa. This project, which will be carried out on behalf of the US electricity company, represents an extension to the 123-megawatt Pomeroy wind farm, construction of which was launched by enXco in June 2007.**

The extension of the Pomeroy project, which will add 75 megawatts of capacity, will comprise 50 GE turbines, each with 1.5 megawatts of capacity. It will be built immediately after completion of the initial 123-megawatt wind farm, the development and construction of which were also entrusted by MidAmerican to enXco, EDF Energies Nouvelles' US subsidiary.

After Wall Lake (150 megawatts) in 2005, Pomeroy (123 megawatts) in 2006 and Goodnoe (94 megawatts) in 2007, enXco has now signed its fourth contract with MidAmerican Energy Holdings Company business platforms MidAmerican Energy and PacifiCorp.

This latest announcement comes hot on the heels of the June 2007 agreement with another US utility, Xcel Energy, covering the development and the construction of a 100-megawatt facility in Minnesota.

The development and construction of wind farms on behalf of third parties represent an integral part of EDF Energies Nouvelles' strategy. This Development and Sale of Structured Assets (DSSA) business is carried out in the United States to meet demand from utilities, who wish to own wind energy facilities. It generates revenue for the Group, which helps to cover the bulk of its development costs.

### **About EDF Energies Nouvelles**

Founded in 1990, EDF Energies Nouvelles is a world-class player in the green electricity generation market, with gross installed capacity of 1,037 MW worldwide at 31 December 2006 (including net capacity of 770 MW), plus 615 MW in gross capacity under construction (including 401 MW net). With a presence in 9 European countries and in the United States, EDF Energies Nouvelles operates in four renewable energy segments (wind, hydro, biomass and solar). Wind energy currently accounts for nearly 80% of its installed capacity. With its unique profile as an integrated operator, EDF Energies Nouvelles, which posted 2006 revenues of €334.8 million and EBITDA of €91.8 million, has a presence spanning the entire value chain, from development and construction through to production and operations & maintenance. The Group also pursues the development and sale of structured assets, which consists primarily in selling renewable energy generating assets to individuals or to energy services companies. EDF Energies Nouvelles is a 50%-owned subsidiary of the EDF group.
