Nine month 2007 revenues: €283.4 million

EDF Energies Nouvelles has reported consolidated revenues for the first nine months of the 2007 financial year of €283.4 million, representing an increase of 9.9% compared with the first nine months of the previous year. At constant exchange rates, revenues grew by 14.6%.

- The Generation segment, which was driven by wind energy production, continued to expand at a rapid pace, with revenues increasing 27.4%;
- The performance of the Development and Sale of Structured Assets (DSSA) segment was boosted by the launch of construction of 292 MW at the Pomeroy and Goodnoe projects in the US. Revenues came to €146.2 million over the first nine months of the year, including €14.5 million during the third quarter alone;
- The Group has reiterated its operational and financial objectives for the full year.

- The **Generation** segment, which represents the Group's core business and key profitability driver, continued to grow at a rapid pace. Its revenues reached €41.8 million during the third quarter, resulting in an increase of 27.4% over the first nine months of the year at €129.7 million. This growth, which was driven to a great extent by wind energy generation, was nonetheless impacted by a much lower level of hydro production during the first nine months of 2007 than in the same period of 2006.
The highlights of the third quarter included the commissioning of the Perdikovouni and Kalyva wind farms in Greece (36 MW), which increased the Group's net installed capacity to 904.1 MW.
- The **Operations & Maintenance** segment posted revenues of €7.5 million in the nine months to 30 September 2007, including €3.5 million specifically for the third quarter. Three major O&M contracts covering 479 turbines with a total capacity of 718 MW were signed in the United States during the quarter.
- The **Development and Sale of Structured Assets** (DSSA) segment recorded revenues totalling €146.2 million over the nine months to 30 September, including €114.5 million during the third quarter. In line with previous announcements, some of the revenues related to the Pomeroy (198 MW) and Goodnoe (94 MW) projects in the United States were posted in the third quarter, but the bulk of revenues from these two facilities is expected during the fourth quarter.

Outlook:

EDF Energies Nouvelles has reiterated its full-year 2007 EBITDA target of between €125 million and €135 million.

EDF Energies Nouvelles also forecasts net income Group share in excess of €40 million and net installed capacity of over 1,000 MW.

Founded in 1990, EDF Energies Nouvelles is a world-class player in the green electricity generation market, with gross installed capacity of 1,188 MW worldwide at 30 June 2007 (including net capacity of 868 MW), plus 1,199 MW in gross capacity under construction (including 630 MW net). With a presence in 9 European countries and in the United States, EDF Energies Nouvelles operates in four renewable energy segments (wind, solar, biomass and hydro). Wind energy currently accounts for more than 80% of its installed capacity. With its unique profile as an integrated operator, EDF Energies Nouvelles, which posted 2006 revenues of €334.8 million and EBITDA of €91.8 million, has a presence spanning the entire value chain, from development and construction through to production and operations & maintenance. The Group also pursues the development and sale of structured assets, which consists primarily in selling renewable energy generating assets to individuals or to energy services companies. EDF Energies Nouvelles is a 50%-owned subsidiary of the EDF group.
